At the Provincial Chapter in December 2021, the proposal to implement the Corporate Stance Against Racism received overwhelming support.


We will be asking for **your** input as the JPIC Office plans the implementation of the Corporate Stance. Look for a survey to come to your email inbox soon!

National Goals—On the provincial level, how can we make intentional and transformative choices that embrace anti-racist principles?


